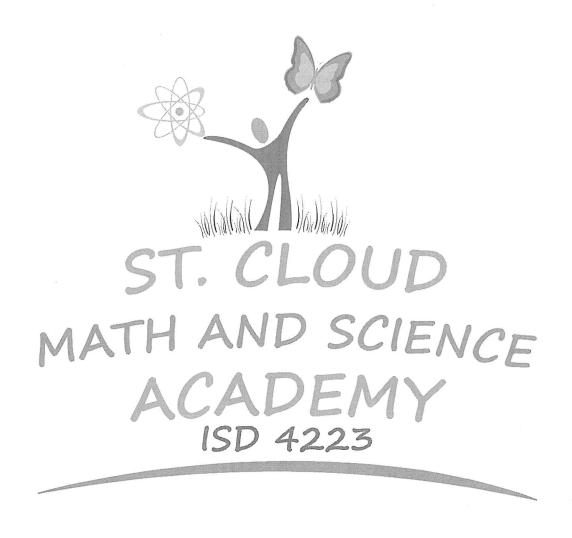

Summary of Key Financial Indicators

- * The School's current revised budget projects a net surplus for the year of \$296,367. A projected cumulative fund balance of \$1,847,792 or 35% of expenditures at fiscal year-end.

Financial Statement Key Points

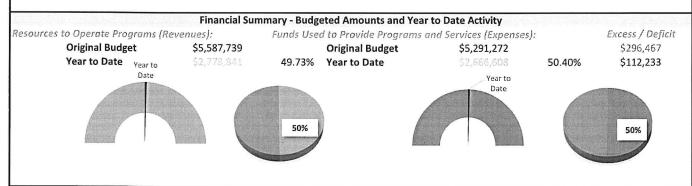
- * As of month-end, 50% of the year was complete.

- * Expenditures disbursed at end of the reporting period -50%

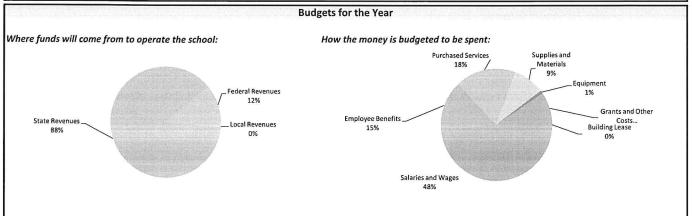

It is not meant to be used to accurately predict what expenditures will be incurred in the short-term. Due to the manner in which MDE regulates the funding, abrupt changes may occur in the amounts of the payments. However, the total amount of the state aids should be reasonable given a stable budget.

This financial report is prepared in a modified format in that they exclude footnotes and required supplementary information in order to be considered a full set of financial statements. 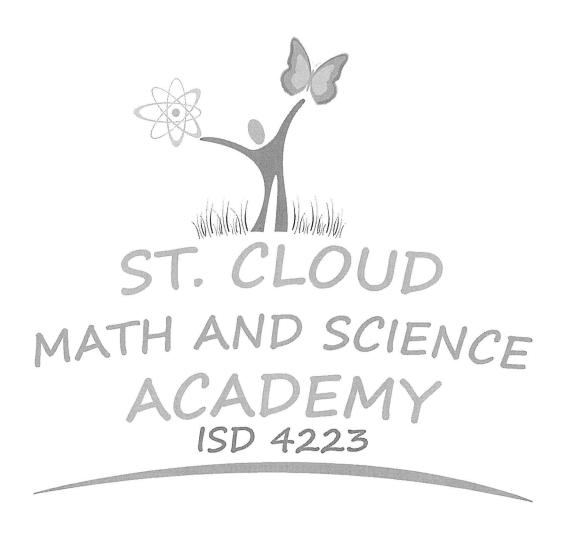
